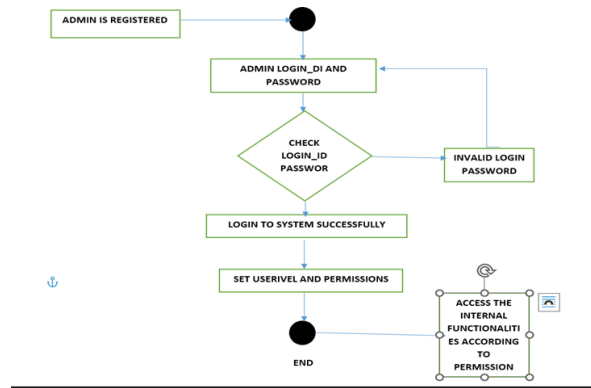


Figure: Use Case Diagrams

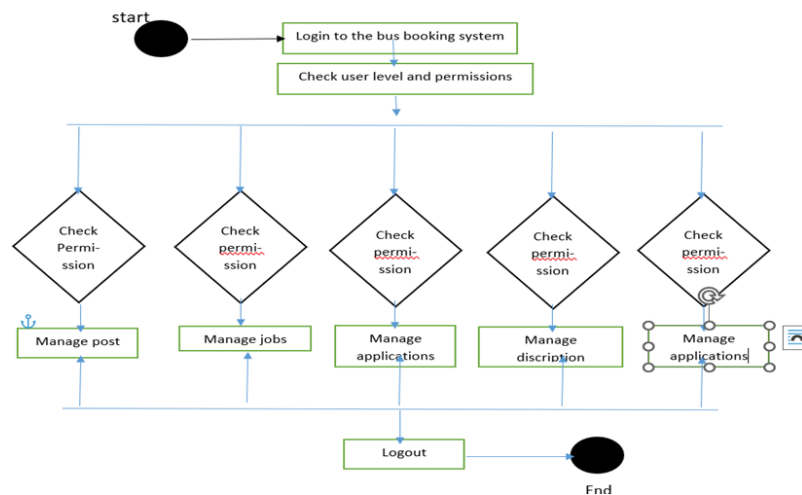


Figure: Class diagram
